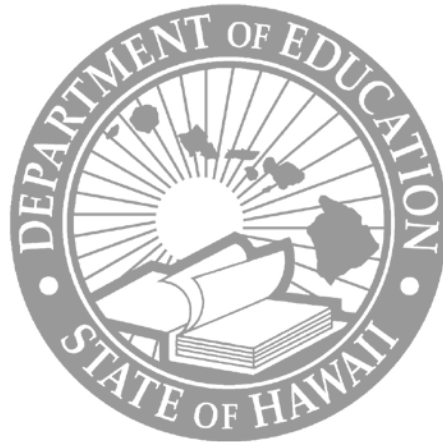

Annual Report on State Educational Facilities Repair and Maintenance Account

December 2020

Section 36-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), requires the Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) to annually report on expenditures for repair and maintenance undertaken pursuant to this section and as related to the State Educational Facilities Repair and Maintenance Account.

The State Educational Facilities Repair and Maintenance Account itemizes school repair and maintenance needs identified before July 1, 2001.

There are no repair and maintenance needs that meet these qualifications.

In accordance with the sunset provision in Section 36-35(h), HRS, this reporting requirement was repealed effective July 1, 2020; therefore, this will be the final report by the Department on the State Educational Facilities Repair and Maintenance Account.
