# **Annual Report of the Capital Improvement Project Funds**

December 28, 2017

Act 49 HB100, 2017 Part VII, Section 58 requires that the Governor shall submit a report to the Legislature of all supplemental allotments made to State Educational Facilities projects for the previous twelve month periods from December 1 to November 30 no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the regular sessions of 2018 and 2019.

Act 49 HB100, 2017 Part VII, Section 58

In the event that currently authorized appropriations specified for capital investment purposes listed in this Act or in any other Act currently authorized by the legislature are insufficient, and where the source of funding for the project is designated as the state educational facilities improvement special fund, the governor may make supplemental allotments from the special funded project adjustment fund for state educational facilities; provided that the supplemental allotments from the special funded project adjustment fund for state educational facilities shall not be used to increase the scope of the project and may only be made to supplement currently authorized capital investment project cost elements; provided further that the governor shall submit a report to the legislature of all uses of this authority for the previous twelve-month period from December 1 to November 30, no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the regular sessions of 2018 and 2019.

No supplemental allotments were made by the Governor from the Department of Education project adjustment fund in the previous twelve-month period.



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
