Program Summary/Purpose

In accordance with the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA) grant requirements and the Hawaii Unified State Plan, funds will be utilized to provide Adult Basic Education (ABE), Workplace Literacy, Integrated Education and Training (IET), Family Literacy, and English Language Acquisition (ELA) instruction at the Community Schools for Adults (CSAs) and their respective campuses.

These programs will provide opportunities for adults by enabling them to master the skills and strategies required for responsible citizenship, productive employment, college readiness, and family self-sufficiency.

Rationale for Allocation

GENERAL FUND ALLOCATIONS ARE TENTATIVE. THE AMOUNTS ALLOCATED MAY BE REDUCED BY EXECUTIVE RESTRICTIONS AND/OR INTERNAL REDUCTIONS.

\$281,231 in "T" funds will be allocated to CSA-Honolulu-Kauai-Maui-Moanalua, ORG ID 976000, and \$749,070 in "T" funds will be allocated to CSA-Hawaii-Leeward-Wahiawa-Windward, ORG ID 977000 to provide instruction in various literacy programs as described in the approved AEFLA grant.

Guidelines for Implementation

A. Use of Funds

State-administered grant funds will be guided by:

1. H.R. 803 WIOA Title II AEFLA Section 221 State Administration; Section 222 State Distribution of Funds: Matching Requirement; Section 231 Grants and Contracts for Eligible Providers; and
2. EDGAR 34 CFR Part 76.

If regular or casual employees are paid from this funding, reports must be submitted to meet federal guidelines. Please refer to the Federal Payroll Certifications and Fringe Benefit Rate memo links.

B. Supplement Not Supplant

AEFLA Section 241(a) states: "Funds made available for adult education and literacy activities under this title shall supplement and not supplant other State or local public funds expended for adult education and literacy activities."

Supplanting would be presumed in these situations:

1. Federal funds are used to provide services that were supported by state or local funds in the prior year.
2. Federal funds are used to provide services the state or local agency is required to make available under federal, state, or local laws.

C. Allowable Costs

All costs must be:

1. Reasonable: incurred by a prudent person, and necessary for the performance of the project;
2. Allocable: proportional and charged in accordance with benefits received;
3. Authorized: in accordance with AEFLA, Uniform Guidance, EDGAR, state or local laws and regulations; and
4. Adequately documented.

The funds are to be expended in accordance with the guidelines found in the "Financial Management System (FMS) User Policy & Process Flow Guide," personnel rules and regulations, and procurement law.

All cost-saving measures, restrictions, and/or spending prohibitions as declared by the Superintendent will apply until such measures are rescinded. These measures include procurement of facilities, meals, refreshments, and intra-state/out-of-state travel.
